Council meet in called session. Members present. Messrs Huggins Leonard Noble Dishpan & Lind.

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved.

The following Ordinance presented by Mr Huggins to accept the plat of the Franklin Land Co designated as Bullitt Park Place & Ordinance No 10. See Ordinance Book Page 24

Motion carried by full vote of year to suspend the rules and place the ordinance on its passage. A vote was then taken on the passage of the ordinance which was carried by a full vote of the year. Mr Huggins presented a resolution to grant Mr Humil and others permission to improve Broad St from the west corporate line to the east corporate line of the Village of Bexley. A vote was then taken on the resolution which was carried by a full vote of the year.

Mr Holzman requested Council to grant he and Mr Latham permission to improve Dale Ave from Park View Ave to Westland and Westland north 200 feet or more grading and improving to be done according to their suggestion. A resolution was offered to grant the above request which was carried by a full vote of the year. Mr Noble asked to be excused for the balance of the session which was granted.

Motion carried that the street and alley com. investigate the drain across Parkview Ave north of Mr Holzman and one near Mr Jefferys to see what repairs were needed and to have them repaired at once according to their own judgement.

Mr. Petzinger presented the following resolution. *8

Be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio,

That it is necessary to extend the drain now existing on the north side of Main Street from Alum Creek to the intersection of the east line of the property owned by Mrs. Elizabeth McCraughten to a point on the north side of Main Street at the intersection of the east line of the property owned by Mrs. Margaret F. McCarty, said drain to be so extended in a straight line from the point where the same now terminates to the point aforesaid, all according to the profile herewith presented and herewith filed.

Be it further resolved that said drain be extended by using therein and in the construction thereof fifteen (15) inch sewer tile with the joints thereof cemented from the present terminus thereof to the east line of Drexel Avenue, and twelve (12) inch sewer tile with the joints thereof cemented from the east line of Drexel Avenue to the point aforesaid; each lot through or in front of which said drain may pass in the construction thereof to have at least one six (6) inch connection, such connection to be located as owners of such lot desires, and a drop shall be placed in connection with such drain on each side of said Drexel Avenue.

Be it further resolved that the cost of extending said drain as aforesaid shall be borne and paid by the owners of the respective lots through which or in front of which the same may pass; that is to say, the owner of each lot through which or in front of which said drain may pass shall pay for the construction thereof through or in front of such lot; the Village of Bexley shall construct and pay for the drain across said Drexel Avenue together with the drops herein above provided for.

Be it further resolved, that the owners of each lot through which or in front of which said drain may pass, shall have the privilege of putting in said drain, in manner and way as above provided, across or in front of the lot so owned by him, and in such event such owner shall not pay any further or additional sum in the matter of the costs thereof.

Provided however, that should any of such owners fail or neglect or refuse to put in said drain across or in front of his respective lot within thirty (30) days after the proceedings necessary to construct said drain shall go into effect, then that portion of such drain shall be constructed and put in by the proper Village Authorities of the Village of Bexley, Ohio, and the cost thereof shall be collected according to law.

Be it further resolved, that the clerk be and is hereby directed to cause this resolution to be published in the manner provided by law.

Resolution offered to improve Carl Rue Ave.

Be it resolved by the Council of Bexley, that Carl Rue Ave. be improved by placing a wooden culvert in the low place near College Ave. and that a shallow gutter be run six feet from the north side of Carl Rue Ave. wherever necessary to the intersection with Pleasant Ridge Ave. to furnish dirt for the approaches to aforesaid culvert.

Motion carried to instruct the street com. to proceed to have such repairs made as was necessary to carry the surface water only.

Resolution^{#10} offered by Mr Leonard to improve College Ave. at the Ohio Electric crossing.

Inasmuch as the intersection of College Avenue with the Ohio Electric Railway tracks constitutes at present an undesirable crossing:-

Be it resolved that this crossing be remedied by removing the cracked stone from the surface of College Avenue at least three rods on each side of said tracks, grading the surface down to such an extent that when the surface is replaced there shall be an even grade from the top of the rails of the track for the said three rods.

Be it further resolved that the contract for same be let at the earliest date possible to the lowest responsible bidder.

Motion to accept the resolution was carried by a full vote of the Yeas.

Motion carried instructing the street committee to proceed at once to improve the streets of the Village by placing crushed stone where most needed the sum of Five Hundred (\$500) Dollars being appropriated for repairs, the same to be done at once.

Motion carried that the east half of Cassidy Ave. which has been donated for public use be opened at once and that the street commissioner be instructed to take the legal proceedings to have all obstructions removed at once.

Motion carried instructing the clerk and treasurer to place the two Hundred forty one dollars (\$241) Dow Liquor Tax received to the credit of the road fund.

Motion carried appointing Mr Leonard and Mr Petzinger a com. to consult Mr DeWitt Lejour in regard to employing him as legal advisor of Council. No other business the meeting adjourned to meet on the next regular meeting night.
