An Ordinance No 21 (To prevent) - for the Cutting of Weeds
growing on Streets, alleys, highways, Commons, and on all lots and lands
within the village of Beavley, Ohio, and prescribing penalty for failure to
do so on or before ~~July 1st~~ and Sept 1st (or
to do on or before August 1st of every year)

Be it ordained by the Council of the village of Beavley Ohio,
Section 1. That Whosoever as owner, agent in charge, or tenant in posses-
sion of any lot or land in said village suffers weeds to grow thereon, and
fails to cut the same on or before ~~July 1st and Sept 1st~~ of each & every year, Shall
be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof on hear-
ing before the mayor shall be fined not less than \$10 ⁰⁰ nor more than
\$25 ⁰⁰ and be required to pay the costs of prosecution.

Section 2:- It is hereby made a part of the duties of the Street
Commissioners of the village, on or before August 1st of every year, (or soo
oner if requested so to do by resolution of Council) to Cut, or cause to
be Cut all rank weeds found growing upon any Street, alley, highway
or public Common of the village at a cost not to exceed 25 cents per
hour. And it is hereby made the duty of said Street Commissioners upon
failure or omission of all persons mentioned in Section 1 of this
Ordinance to Cut the weeds on any lots or lands described herein
by the date named to Cut, or cause to be Cut said weeds immediately
~~July 1st and Sept 1st~~
after ~~August 1st~~, at the expense of the persons whose duty this herein

and to let said lands, and the expense and cost for letting said lands
to be reported to the Council, Shall not exceed twenty five cents per
hour, to be collected by the Clerk, and upon failure or refusal of
owner, agent or lessee of said lot or land to pay said Clerk
the Council may cause said cost & expenses to be recovered against
said lots & lands, and collected on the treasurership in the name
of the legal owner -

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force
from & after its passage & publication according to law.
