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An Ordinance No 21 (To prev. for the Cutting of Weeds
growing on Streets, alleys, highways, Commons, and on all lots and lands
within the village of Piquette Ohio, and prescribing penalty for failure to
do so on or before ~~August 1st~~ ^{July 1st and Sept 1st} of every year)

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Piquette Ohio,

Section 1. That whosoever as owner, agent in charge, or tenant in possession of any lot or land in said village suffers weeds to grow thereon, and fails to cut the same on or before ~~August 1st~~ ^{July 1st and Sept 1st} of each & every year, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof on hearing before the mayor shall be fined not less than \$10⁰⁰ nor more than \$25⁰⁰ and be required to pay the costs of prosecution.

Section 2:- It is hereby made a part of the duties of the Street Commissioner of the village, on or before August 1st of every year, (or sooner if requested to do so by resolution of Council) to cut, or cause to be cut all rank weeds found growing upon any Street, alley, highway or public grounds of the village at a cost not to exceed 25 cents per house. And it is hereby made the duty of said Street Commissioner upon failure or omission of all persons mentioned in Section 1 of this Ordinance to cut the weeds on any lots or lands designated herein by the date named to cut or cause to be cut said weeds immediately after ~~August 1st~~ ^{July 1st and Sept 1st}, at the expense of the persons whose duty it is having

and to cut said roads, and the expense and cost for cutting said roads to be reported to the Council, shall not exceed twenty five cents per hour, to be collected by the Clerk, and upon failure or refusal of owner, agent or lessee of said lot or land to pay said Clerk the Council may cause said cost & expense to be assessed against said lots & lands, and collected on the tax duplicate in the name of the legal owner.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from & after its passage & publication according to law.
