AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A VILLAGE BASE OR PLANE OF REFERENCE AND FIXING THE ELEVATION OF A PRIMAL BENCH MARK.

Be it ordained by
The council of the Village of Bexley, Franklin County, State of Ohio, december as follows:-

Section 1. That the Village Base or Plane of Reference for elevations in the Village of Bexley is hereby fixed at a point 100 feet below the extreme northeast corner of the northeast water table of the State Capitol, located in the city of Columbus, Franklin County Ohio .

Section 2. The cross cut in the top of a copper holt set in the top of the south wing wall of the west abutment of the Main Street bridge over Alum Creek is hereby declared to be the Primal Bench Mark and the celevation thereof is seventy-nine feet and six hundred and forty-nine one thousandths of a foot (79.649 feet), above Village Base.

Section 3. All official elevations hereafter established in the Village of Bexley, Franklin County, Ohio, shall be described with reference to their elevations as compared with the official base in feet and decimal parts of a foot. No grades nor official elevations shall be established other than by ordinance and in the manner described in this ordinance.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on and after the earliest time allowed by law.
