Mr. Brammacher then presented

Resolution # 28

To employ and regulate the employing of
Village Engineers

Whereas the nature of civil and sanitary engineering work within the Village of Bexley is irregular and changeable from time to time, and whereas it is to the best interest of the Village of Bexley to employ such engineers by contract and by per day as the needs of the Village may require,

Be it therefore resolved by the Council of the Village of Bexley of the State of Ohio, that a civil engineer be chosen by the Village Council to act as civil engineer for the Village of Bexley, who shall perform all such work as civil engineering at a per day rate or contract rate for the Village, and that a sanitary engineer be chosen by the Village Council to act as sanitary engineer for the Village of Bexley when called upon, who shall perform all such work at a per day rate or contract rate for the Village.

The Village Council shall at a regular meeting at the beginning of each fiscal year choose such engineer or engineers for the ensuing year or fill vacancies during the year authorizing the Mayor with the clerk of the Village to enter into contract with such elected engineers or engineers in accordance with this resolution.

Be it further resolved, that all ordinances and resolutions in conflict with this resolution
