An Ordinance No 30

(To levy special assessments on Pleasant Ridge Avenue property)

Be it ordered by the Council of the village of Bixley, State of Ohio, as follows:-

Section I. That in order to defray all the cost and expense of improving Pleasant Ridge Avenue in said village, from Monroe Street to the back side of Rock Run Avenue, by grading and levelling the roadway, and constructing a tile drain, and including the expense of Engineers Survey, amounting in the aggregate, to the sum of \$456⁷⁰, take a special assessment of $25\frac{5}{8}$ Cents for front foot of the lots and lands abutting on both sides of said Pleasant Ridge Avenue, be and is hereby levied and imposed upon each and every front foot of the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said Pleasant Ridge Avenue from Monroe Street to the back side of Rock Run Avenue to wit:-

Section 2. That the total assessment against each lot or parcel of land herein
shall be payable in cash within 30 days after the date of the final
passage of this Ordinance, or in two equal annual installments with
interest at the rate of Six per cent per annum upon deferred payments, at
the option of the Owner. All cash payments shall be made to the
Village Treasurer. All cash payments of said assessments not made
to said Village Treasurer on or before the date hereby fixed, shall
be remitted to the Village Clerk by the Village Treasurer and by said
Clerk shall be certified to the Auditor of Franklin County Ohio for him
to be by said Auditor to be placed on the tax duplicate of said County
for collection with interest and penalties allowed by law.

Section 3. That former Ordinance No 29 making an amendment on January first
for the above improvement in the sum is hereby repealed.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and
after the earliest period allowed by law.
