An Ordinance N<sup>o</sup> 30

(To levy Special Assessments on Pleasant Ridge Avenue property)

Be it ordained by the Council of the village of Bixby, State of Ohio, as follows:-

Section I, That in order to defray all the cost and expense of improving Pleasant Ridge Avenue in said village, from Mount Street to the North Side of Maple Run Avenue, by grading and leveling the roadway, and constructing a tile drain, and including the expense of Engineers Survey, amounting in the aggregate, to the sum of \$456<sup>70</sup>, that a special assessment of 25<sup>6</sup>/<sub>100</sub> Cents per front foot of the lots and lands abutting on both sides of said Pleasant Ridge Avenue, be and is hereby levied and imposed upon each and every front foot of the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said Pleasant Ridge Avenue from Mount Street to the North Side of Maple Run Avenue to-wit:-

Section 2. That the total assessment against each lot or parcel of land herein shall be payable in cash within 30 days after the date of the final passage of this Ordinance, or in two equal annual installments with interest at the rate of Six per cent per annum upon deferred payments, at the option of the Owner. All cash payments shall be made to the Village Treasurer. All cash payments of said assessments not made to said Village Treasurer on or before the date hereby fixed, shall be reported to the Village Clerk by the Village Treasurer and by said Clerk a Certificate to the Auditor of Franklin County Ohio for transmittal to be by said Auditor to be placed on the tax duplicate of said County

Section 3. for Collection with interest and penalties allowed by law. That former Ordinance No 29 making assessment on white property for the above improvement be the same is hereby repealed.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
