

Ordinance No. 35.

(Authorizing and directing the Mayor and Clerk to sign and execute written contracts for a water supply and the construction of a joint sewer and for the sewage disposal of the village of Dexley, Ohio between the village of Dexley, Ohio and the City of Columbus, Ohio.)

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Dexley, State of Ohio:-

That the Mayor and Clerk of said Village be authorized and directed on behalf of said Village to enter into a written contract with the City of Columbus, Ohio for a period of twenty years, which shall provide for said City of Columbus, Ohio furnishing a water supply to the Village of Dexley, Ohio and its inhabitants for a consideration in said written contract expressed and on the terms and conditions therein stipulated; and also that said Mayor and Clerk be authorized and directed on behalf of said Village to enter into a written contract with the City of Columbus, Ohio for a period of twenty years which shall provide for said City of Columbus, Ohio through a joint sewer to be constructed by said Village of Dexley, Ohio from the east corporation line of said City of Columbus, Ohio at its own expense to the sewage pumping station of the City of Columbus, Ohio in east Main Street, near Alum Creek, upon the terms and conditions expressed in said written agreement.

That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
