Resolution # 38

Resolution to appoint a committee to confer with the City of Columbus for the purpose of securing water supply for the Village of Bexley with Accompanied Agreement.

Whereas our Village Sanitary Engineer, Mr. Kimberly cannot give definite and complete estimates of cost of sewer and of water mains until it is definitely decided from what source the said Village of Bexley will procure its water; and whereas it will be better for the Village of Bexley to secure its water supply from Columbus if it can be obtained, than for said Village to construct its own water works;

Be it therefore resolved, that the Mayor be appointed a committee of one, who shall confer with the Council of the City of Columbus with the above end in view, leading to an agreement between the City of Columbus and the Village of Bexley as to water supply, the said matter to be disposed of in the near future, and be it further resolved that the Mayor and the Clerk of the Village of Bexley, subject to the approval of the Council of said Village, be herewith authorized to enter into such agreement leading to a proper contract being entered into between Columbus and Bexley with reference to the above water supply.
