

ORDINANCE NO. 42

Ordinance to Appropriate Property for Trunk Sewer
Line Purposes.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring,

Sec. 1. That the following described property be and the same is hereby appropriated to public use for a trunk sewer line purposes leading to the Sewage Treatment Plant on the property of the said Village of Bexley for the disposal of the sewage of said Village of Bexley, to-wit:-

A right of way or easement in a strip of land fifteen (15) feet wide and about six hundred (600) feet long, more or less, over, through and across the following described tract of land, situated in the State of Ohio, Franklin County and in Marion Township, and being part of Half Section 34, Township 5, Range 22, Refugee Lands, and being Lot Number 2 of a Plat made in the Partition Suit in the Court of Common Pleas of Franklin County, Ohio, wherein, Virginia B. Livingston was Plaintiff and Martha A. Brown and others were defendants, and which said Lot No. 2 was assigned by said Commissioners in partition to said Virginia B. Livingston and confirmed by the said Court; said Lot No. 2 being described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit;- Beginning in the center of the "Columbus and Winchester Turnpike" and being one of the corners to Lot No. 1 in said partition plat above referred to, and running thence with the center line of said Turnpike south $29\frac{1}{2}$ East 47-08/100 poles to the Northeast corner of Lot No. 3 of said Partition Plat; thence with North line of said Lot No. 3, 87 West, passing a stone planted on the West side of said Columbus and Winchester Turnpike 115-76/100 poles to the center of Alum Creek, passing a stone on East bank thereof;

thence up the center of said Alum Creek with the meanders thereof to the Southwest corner of said Lot No. 1; thence with the line of said Lot No. 1 South 87 East 103-56/100 poles to the place of beginning, containing 25½ acres, more or less, owned by Jacob S. Wolf of Reynoldsburg, Ohio, and Margaret J. Eberly of Columbus, Ohio as the heirs at law and next kin of John Wolf, late of Franklin County, Ohio, who died intestate. The said sewer line entering upon these above described premises on the North line thereof about 340 feet from the center line of Columbus and Winchester Turnpike, and passing through the above described premises in a southerly direction crossing the South line thereof about 1100 feet west of the center line of Columbus and Winchester Turnpike, as said sewer line is delineated on profiles on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio.

Sec. 2. That the Solicitor of the said Village of Bexley be and is hereby authorized and directed to apply to a court of competent jurisdiction to have a jury impaneled to make inquiry into and assess the compensation to be paid for such property.

Sec. 3. That the costs and expenses of said appropriation be paid out of the Sewage Disposal and Water Supply Fund.

Sec. 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
