Resolution for the Village of Bexley to make a donation for the sufferers in Columbus caused by the recent flood.

Whereas the recent flood brought about much suffering within Columbus appeals for help and aid from all spared from this awful calamity, and whereas the Governor of the State of Ohio, has called for help from all those able to help in the great distress of the State of Ohio at this time, and whereas the Mayor of the City of Columbus has also sent his appeals for help, and whereas Bexley is so closely identified with Columbus,

Therefore, Be it resolved that we as Council of the Village of Bexley express herewith our sincere sympathy to the City of Columbus in its great affliction.

That the Council for the Village of Bexley herewith contribute out of the Village Funds \$250.00 toward the relief fund of the City of Columbus, Ohio, and place the same in the hands of the Mayor of Columbus to be used for the suffering in Columbus, and

That we call upon all the people of the Village of Bexley to assist with food, clothing or money in caring for the flood stricken people of Columbus, and that a committee be appointed to collect and receive such donations made by the people and deliver the same to the Columbus Relief Committee

That a copy of this resolution be sent the Mayor of the City of Columbus, Ohio.
