

Resolution # 50

Resolution to advertise for bids for the sewerage treatment plant.

Be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Pexley, State of Ohio.

That the clerk be and he is hereby authorized to advertise in two local papers of general circulation in the Village once a week for 5 consecutive weeks, and two insertions in each of the following magazines, Engineers Record, 239 Br. 39th Street New York. Engineering and Contracting, 608 Dearborn St. Chicago, and the American Contractor also of Chicago, for bids for the construction of the Sewage treatment plant. The following form to be used.

Until 12 O'clock noon standard time on the 13th day of May A.D. 1913 sealed bids will be received by the clerk of the incorporated Village of Pexley, Franklin County, Ohio, for constructing a municipal sewage treatment plant in accordance with plans and specifications on file at the Capitol Barber Shop, Main Street Pexley, and also at the office of the engineer, A. Elliott Kimberly No. 8 E. Long Street Columbus Ohio. Plans and specifications may be obtained for personal use upon payment of three dollars (\$3.00). Proposals shall be sealed and shall be made upon the proposal blanks furnished by the Village and shall be addressed to George E. Fry Village Clerk.

Each proposal shall be accompanied by a certified check in the sum of One Thousand dollars (\$1000.00) made payable to the clerk of said Village as a guarantee that if the bid is accepted, a contract will be entered into within ten days after the acceptance of the proposal. The Village reserves the right to reject any or all bids.
