

Resolution # 52.

Resolution Regulating the Number of Y-connections to be Placed in the Sewer System of the Village of Berley, Ohio.

Whereas the Village of Berley, State of Ohio, is about to install a system of sanitary sewers, said cost to be met by a bond issue rather than by assessment and the division of the Village into districts, and whereas the sizes of the lots vary as to the plats and subdivisions of the same. Now, Therefore be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Berley, State of Ohio:

1. That all lots north of Main Street, exclusive of Main Street lots shall have one Y-connection placed in the sewer for each lot in front of which the sewer shall be constructed, except lots Nos. One to Fifty-one (1-51), Round and Knauss Park View Addition to Berley, which lots shall have two Y-connections for each such lot in front of which the sewer shall be constructed;
2. That all acreage north of Main Street shall have one Y-connection for every 100 ft. and fraction of 50 ft. frontage along the line of sewers as constructed;
3. That all lots on Main Street and south thereof shall have one Y-connection for each lot of 60 mft. and less frontage, provided, however, that all lots over 60 ft. frontage shall have Y-connection in the said sewer line for every 60 ft. and fraction of 30 ft.;
4. That all acreage on Main Street and south thereof shall have one connection for every 60 ft. frontage and fraction of 30 ft.;
5. That all lots and tracts of land used for public purposes shall be provided with only such connections as are necessary

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irrespective of the size and extent of said lot or
lots or tracts of land.
