

Resolution # 54

Resolution to send a committee to Represent the Village of Berkley at the Water Committee of the Council of the City of Columbus, Ohio.

Whereas, on Monday night May, 5, 1913 at the Council meeting of the City of Columbus, Ohio, the matter of the Village of Berkley obtaining its water supply from Columbus was brought up, and

Whereas two of the citizens of Berkley were present at said Council meeting urging some action on same be taken, and
 Whereas the Chairman of the Water Committee of the Council of Columbus, Ohio, with the wish of other councilmen of said City has called a meeting of said committee for May 9th, for the special purpose of considering the giving of water to the Village of Berkley, and

Whereas the said Chairman and other councilmen have expressed the wish that Mr. A. R. Geist and Mr. E. S. Underwood, who as citizens of Berkley, urged immediate steps be taken, be present at said committee meeting and,

Whereas the general consensus of the members of said Council is that a 2 cent per 1000 gallon contract be made,

Therefore be it resolved,
 That Mr. Geist and Mr. Underwood be herewith appointed by this Council of the Village of Berkley, Ohio to represent the Village of Berkley at the said meeting of the Water Committee or at any meeting of said Water Committee of the Council of the City of Columbus should meet for the consideration of supplying Berkley with Water.

And be it further resolved to grant this committee the power to agree to a rat or
