

Resolution # 58.

Resolution for the purpose of obtaining right of way on Livingston Avenue for Sewer Line.

Whereas the plans for disposal of the Sewer of the Village of Berley, State of Ohio, require that the sewer line on College Avenue (col. 2nd Winchester Pike) extend to the centre of Livingston Avenue, the said Livingston Ave. crossing College Ave. (col. Winchester Pike), and running thence westward along the centre of Livingston Avenue 710 feet at a depth of about 8 feet, and thence running at right angles to the south line of said Livingston Avenue; and

Whereas the said Livingston Avenue is out side of the Village of Berley, Ohio, and therefore coming solely under the jurisdiction of the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, State of Ohio,

Therefore be it resolved by the Council of the said Village of Berley, State of Ohio, to petition the said Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, to grant said Village of Berley a Right of Way to lay its sewer line in the centre of said Livingston Avenue described as follows:-

Beginning at the north line of said Livingston Avenue when where College Avenue (col. 2nd Winchester Pike) intersects with the said Livingston Avenue, and running thence along centre of said col. 2nd Winchester Pike to the centre of said Livingston Avenue, thence westward along the centre of said Livingston Avenue 710 ft. at a depth of about 8 feet, and thence south across said highway at right angle to the south line of said Livingston Avenue.

Be it further resolved, that the Chairman of the sewer and Water Committee present this resolution to the said Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, State of Ohio, to be acted upon by said Board.
