

Resolutions # 59.

Resolution to Obtain Right of Way on Livingston Avenue for Sewer Line.

Whereas the plans of the sewage disposal of the Village of Berley, State of Ohio, require that the sewer line on College Avenue (Col. 2nd Winchester Pike) be extended along Livingston Avenue 710 feet westward at a depth of about 8 feet in order to connect with the main trunk line of said Village, and

Whereas the Main trunk line of the sewer of said Village of Berley must cross Livingston Avenue at about 710 feet west of the center of the above mentioned Winchester Pike, whereas the County Commissioners of Franklin County State of Ohio have the sole jurisdiction of the said Livingston Avenue,

Therefore be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Berley, State of Ohio, to petition the said Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County to grant said Village of Berley a right of way to lay its sewer line from the center of College Ave. (Col. 2nd Winchester Pike) westward along the north side of said Livingston Avenue 710 feet to connect with the main sewer trunkline and at a depth of about 8 feet, and further to grant the Village of Berley to cross Livingston Ave. at this point with the trunk line & its sewer, the said Village of Berley putting the Street at point crossed approximately in the same condition as at time when crossed with the sewer line.

Be it further resolved that Resolution No. 58 relating to the same proposition be and the same is hereby repealed.
