

## Resolution &amp;c.

Resolution to Acquire Right of Way for Main Sewer Line South of Main Street through the R. W. Bock Property.

Whereas Mr. R. W. Bock in a signed statement has signified to grant the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio the right to lay its trunk sewer line through his property under the following terms:— That he receive a tap for his house <sup>and a tap</sup> for his barn on said property in said trunk line; second, that the ditch near the south line of his property caused by the Village running its storm water into said ditch be filled up and closed; third, that he be not required to receive any unforeseen damage, that might occur; and fourth, that he be paid \$225.00 for the right of way for said sewer trunk line.

Therefore be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio, that Mr. R. W. Bock be paid \$225.00 for the right of way through his property situated south of Main Street and east of Alum Creek, that as a further consideration, a tap be put in this said trunk line for the house connection on this property, and that a tap be granted for the barn on this property for sanitary purposes only.

Be it further resolved, that the Village of Bexley, through its Street Commissioner and Chairman of Street and Alley Committee, investigate the ditch matter on the said R. W. Bock property, and if the finding be, that the Village of Bexley be liable for same, that said ditch be filled.

And

Be it further resolved, that R. W. Bock shall not be <sup>required to</sup> waive any claim to any unforeseen damages that through the construction of said trunk sewer line might occur.
