

Resolution No. 1.

Notification of Property Owners respecting Location of House connection & its in Sanitary Sewers and Arrangements for and the cost of House connections, extending from sewer line to Property Line or to cellar line as desired.

Whereas there is about to be constructed within in the Village of Bexley, Ohio a system of sanitary sewers and,

Whereas openings for house connection are to be left at intervals in accordance with Resolution etc. No. 2. and,

Whereas a property owner may desire a connection at a certain definite point along his frontage and,

Whereas the Village has, through the contractor for the sewers secured a price per linear foot for house sewers for such property owners as may desire immediate connection to the sanitary sewers.

Now therefore, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Bexley, Ohio,

That the clerk be and he is hereby ordered to send a notice to all property owners as follows:-

(A) That within 10 days after receipt of this notice, property owners shall designate by a stake opposite what point in their property they desire a house Y-connection to be located and that in case such stakes are not driven, or in case the point of Y is not otherwise designated, the house Y-connection will be placed at a point in the sewer line at least 15 feet upstream from the intersection of the sewer and the property line produced to meet the sewer line at the lowest point thereof with respect to the said property.

(B) That the contractor for the sewers, Kohlberger and Noyles, have agreed with the Village to construct house sewers, extending from the

center of the sewer line to the property line or to the cellar line at a price of 45¢ per lineal foot for cement joints and 50¢ per lineal foot for asphaltic joints. Property owners who desire house sewers shall notify the Resident Engineer in writing. The cost of such house sewers shall be paid by the property owners and not by the Village. On the event that house sewers are not constructed at the time the sewer trench is open, each Y-connection will be plugged with a vitrified stopper, and a Y-pole will be erected over the same. Exact records will be kept of the location of Y's to facilitate the future construction of house sewers.

Sec. 2.

That the Clerk be and he is hereby directed to have printed contract forms which shall provide for a written agreement between each property owner and Rohbarger & Noyles of Marietta, Ohio, Contractors, authorizing the construction of house sewers and that the said printed contract shall be as per the attached form.
