

Resolution # 68

Resolution Directing to Advertise for Bids for the Construction of the Proposed Water Supply System within the Village of Bexley, Ohio.

Whereas the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio, has been directed by the qualified voters of said Village of Bexley to construct a complete sewer and water supply system for said Village, and

Whereas the sanitary engineer for said Village has completed plans for the construction of said Water Supply System,

Therefore be it Resolved, That a legal notice for bids be published in two newspaper of the City of Columbus of general circulation as provided by law; that said publication shall call for bids for the construction of the Water Supply System and for the furnishing of all material necessary for the construction of same as provided in the plans and specifications prepared by the engineer of said Village of Bexley, and on file in the office of Village Clerk; that said call for bids be so formulated, that the number of feet of water mains to be laid can be increased or decreased at any time at will of the Council of the Village of Bexley; that the legal notice shall also be published in the State Journal Dispatch Engineer Record; and that the legal notice to be published shall be as follows as attached here to:-

Advertisement For Bids.

Until 12 o'clock noon, Standard Time on the 28 day of July A. D. 1913, sealed bids will be received by the Clerk of the Incorporated Village of Westley, Franklin County, Ohio or his duly authorized representative, for furnishing material for and for constructing a water works distribution system for the said Village, in accordance with specifications therefore on file in the office of the said Clerk and also at the offices of the engineer, A. Elliott Kimberly, East Long St., Columbus, Ohio from whom copies may be obtained.

Proposal will be received separately, as follows:

- Item 1. Furnishing or furnishing and distributing 800 tons e. i. water pipe, Class B. American Water Works Standard, consisting of 6, 8 and 10 inch pipe and 17 tons special castings.
- " 2. Furnishing or furnishing and distributing valves as follows:—
12 8, 4-inch; 4, 8 inch and 2, 10 inches.
- " 3. Furnishing or furnishing and distributing 134 valve boxes.
- " 4. Furnishing or furnishing and distributing 79 fire hydrants.
- " 5. Furnishing or furnishing and distributing 3, 6-inch meter.
- " 5. a. Furnishing or furnishing and distributing 3, 4-inch meters.
- " 6. Laying water mains, setting valves, valve boxes, hydrant meter, connecting to mains of City of Columbus, constructing meter main holes and making two stream crossings.
(a) Excavating, laying and backfill for e. i. pipe and special castings:—

3 6, 5 & 2 in. ft. 2 in. dia.

4, 4 1/2 " " 8 "

2, 4 1/2 " " 10 "

(b.) Setting Valves.

2, 10 inch.

4, 8 inch.

10 8, 6 inch.

(c.) Setting 1 3/4 Valve Boxes.

(d.) Setting 79 Hydrants.

(e.) Setting 3 Meters

(f.) Constructing 3 meter main hole.

(g.) Making 2 Stream crossings.

Each proposal shall contain the name of every person, firm or corporation interested in the same, the address of the president and secretary of a corporation and shall be accompanied by a bond with surety satisfactory to the Village or a certified check on a solvent bank, in either case in the sum of at least ten (10) per cent of the total amount of the bid. Bond shall be in favor of the Bidders; certified check shall be payable to George Fry, Clerk, Bond of fifty (50) per cent of amount of contract required for faithful performance of same.

Above quantities are approximate only and are and are given for basis of uniform comparison of bids. The Village reserves the right to increase or to decrease quantities under any item to accept either of all or any bids, and to waive informality if it appears to its best interest so to do.

The Village reserves the right to reject any or all bids.
