

Resolution #72.

Declaring it necessary to levy a Tax of $\frac{1}{2}$ mill on the dollar on the Tax Duplicate of the Village of Berkeley to raise funds to pay interest on \$107,000 of proposed bonds of said Village Proper Step and appropriate legal action having been taken before taken by this Council to issue and sell the Bonds of said Village of Berkeley, Ohio of the face value of \$13000 bearing 5 per cent interest payable semi-annually after the date thereof, for the purpose of raising funds to complete Water Supply and Sewage Disposal System and to supply a deficit in the said Village Fund for that use; and said Village Council being without authority to use the money of said Village raised for other purposes to pay the interest on these bonds as they fall due, be it resolved by the Council of the said Village of Berkeley, State of Ohio, two thirds of all the members elected there to concurring therein, that it is necessary to raise money by the levy of a public Tax of $\frac{1}{2}$ mill on the dollar of the duplicate in said Village for a period of five years to pay the interest on said bond, and in order to procure authority to levy and to raise by taxation said interest that the question of so raising said interest on said bonds be submitted to a vote of the qualified Electors of said Village of Berkeley at the next regular municipal Election of said Village to be held thereon on the 1st day of November 1918, at the usual place of voting in said Village and said election shall be conducted and the votes canvassed and certified in the same manner as other municipal election and that the Mayor be and is hereby directed to give public notice of the time and place of holding said election in the manner provided by law, and that the Clerk be and thereby is directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Deputy State Supervisor of Elections of Franklin County, Ohio.
