

## Resolution # 78.

Resolutions to appoint a Motor Policeman to assist the Village Marshal in Arresting Transgressors of Law.

Whereas, the safety of the people in going to and from is dependant to a large extent upon the due care exercised by the public in general upon our streets, and

Whereas, many using auto cars or motor-cycles have little regard for the rights of their fellow men and run their machines in excessive speed thus endangering the lives of many people besides infringing upon the rights of the public in general, disregarding all signs and notices of the speed limits,

Therefore be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Berley, Ohio, that a motor policeman be appointed by the Mayor of Berley who shall render assistance to the Marshal of Berley in arresting offenders of the speed law and whose services shall be paid out of the costs paid by the offenders so arrested and fined. And under no condition will cost come from the Village.
