

## Resolution No 74.

Resolution to award Contracts for the Construction of the Water Supply System for the Village of Bexley  
 Whereas, the Committee appointed to examine the various bids received for the material and construction of the Water Supply System for the Village of Bexley, Ohio, recommends that the contract for the construction of same be awarded to J. C. Brooks & Son, of Jackson, Mich. and the contract for the furnishing of the cast iron pipe and special castings, together with the hydrants for said Water Supply System be awarded to Wm. M. Graham, of Columbus, Ohio, therefore

Be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio, that the contract for the labor or construction of the proposed Water Supply System for the Village of Bexley be awarded to the firm of J. C. Brooks & Son, of Jackson, Mich. and

That the contract for the Cast Iron Pipe and special castings necessary for the construction of said Water Supply System and also the contract for the necessary number of hydrants needed for said Water Supply System be awarded to Wm. M. Graham, of Columbus, Ohio, the same being the lowest and best bidders.

Be it further resolved by the Council of said Village of Bexley, that the mayor and Clerk of the Village of Bexley, Ohio be and are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the Village of Bexley, Ohio with the above named parties, J. C. Brooks & Son and Wm. M. Graham, the first party for the labor in connection with the construction of the Water Supply System and the second party for furnishing the Cast Iron Pipe and special castings and for further furnishing the hydrants necessary for the construction of said Water Supply System, and that both parties receiving award of contracts be required as per contract to furnish good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of same.
