

Resolution No. 79 ✓

Resolution authorizing the Submission to a Vote to the People of the Village of Bexley, Ohio, to levy an Additional Tax for the purpose of Taking Care of the Sewer System and the Water Supply System now Being Installed Together with Additional Street Funds Necessary to Improve the Streets within Bexley.

Whereas, our present tax levy for the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio, is limited by the Smith One Per Cent Law to the 1910 tax whereby the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio, has not sufficient funds to meet the additional expenses of operating and taking care of the now installed Sewer System and the Water Supply System, and

Whereas also additional funds will be necessary to improve the streets after the above mentioned sewer and Water Systems are installed, and

Whereas it will require a levy of $\frac{1}{2}$ mill upon each dollar of valuation upon the tax Duplicate of the Village to take care of the above mentioned Systems and $\frac{1}{2}$ mill in addition to present levy for street purposes to meet the most urgent needs in improving the streets of Bexley, therefore,

Be It Resolved by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio, that the levying of $\frac{1}{2}$ mill to take care of the above mentioned systems and $\frac{1}{2}$ mill in addition to the present levy for street purposes be levied on the assessed valuation of the property of the said Village of Bexley, State of Ohio, be submitted to a vote of the qualified electors of said Village of Bexley, Ohio, and

Be it further resolved, that the Mayor of the Village of Bexley, Ohio, be and hereby is authorized and directed to take the necessary legal steps preparatory to submit to a vote of the people of the said Village of Bexley, Ohio, at the coming general election on November

4th, 1913, the proposition of levying said additional taxes aforesaid.

This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
