

## Resolution # 84 ✓

Whereas, The money available in the Sewage disposal and water system Fund is insufficient to cover the cost of constructing sewers, laying water mains, constructing the sewage treatment plant and providing engineering supervision therefor in full accordance with the general plans for the Sewer and water systems and the detailed plans for the sewage treatment plant, and

Whereas, The complete installation of the water distribution system as shown on the general plan is essential to secure full circulation, proper pressure, fire protection and a well working system, and

Whereas, The construction and completion of the sewage treatment plant is essential to the operation of the sanitary sewer system, and

Whereas, as shown on the general plan of the sewer system, sewers have been planned to be laid in certain streets on which at certain parts thereof, abutting lots are not at the present time occupied by residences or other buildings which require sewerage facilities,

Now, Therefore, Be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Bexley, Franklin County, Ohio.

Sec. 1.

That no sewers be constructed upon parts of certain streets and Avenues described as follows:-

- (A) Drexel Ave. from Dale Ave. north to the circle on Broad St.
- (B) Columbia Ave. from a point 100 ft. north of the north property line of No. Commonwealth Ave. to Boston Ave.
- (C) Drexel Ave. north from the manhole at No. Commonwealth Ave. to Boston Ave.
- (D.) Cassady Ave. north of Sts. 4 + 80 corresponding to the north end of the water distribution system to the second manhole shown on the general plans.

Sec. 2. That Kohbarger & Hoyle, Sewer Contractors, be notified by the Engineer that no sewers are to be constructed in the streets as above set forth and that a copy of this resolution be sent to the said contractors.
