

Resolution No 85

Resolution to reset iron pins and other monuments marking the corners of property along College Avenue of the Edw. Livingston Subdivision.

Whereas, in constructing the sewer for the village of Bexley on College Avenue from Livingston Avenue northward to Carlsree Avenue, the stone monument or corner stone at the intersection of Livingston Avenue and College Avenue (Winchester Pike) had to be removed; and

Whereas, all the iron pins along the center of College Avenue from Livingston Avenue to Carlsree Avenue in constructing said sewer were moved, the said iron pins marking the corner of lots of th. Edw. Livingston subdivision of a part of half section 1/4, 20, Township No. 5, Range 22, refugee lands in Marion Township, Franklin County, Ohio;

Therefore be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio, that A Elliott Kimberly Village Engineer be instructed by said Council of Bexley as follows:-

First, to replace said stone monument or to place some other suitable monument at the intersection of Livingston Avenue and College Avenue (Winchester Pike) at point of previous location of said monument; and that the replacing of said monument be witnessed by Mr. E. Brown, Street Director, the Street Commissioner of the Village of Bexley and by the Chairman of the Street and Alley Committee of the Council of Village of Bexley, and that the said witnessing be signed by all above parties mentioned together with the engineer replacing the same and the same be placed on file with the Clerk of the Village of Bexley;

Second that said engineer place all iron pins moved in the construction of the above mentioned sewer instead of in the center of College Avenue as formerly located, along the east and west line of said College Avenue from Livingston Avenue to Carlsree Avenue, the said iron pins to be so placed to accurately mark the corner of the lots

on both the east and the west side of said College Avenue, as said lots are on record in the plat of Edw. Livingston Subdivision now of Bexley, plat book 2 page 278, Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio;

Third, that said engineer also mark the corners of all streets of the Edw. Livingston Subdivision crossing College Avenue with iron pins; and Fourth, that the said engineer make out a record of these iron pins together with the distance from the center of College Avenue along the lot line to said iron pin, the said record to be filed with the Clerk of the Village of Bexley, and the same to be open for inspection and consultation by all parties interested.
