

Resolution # 86

Resolution to order parties unlawfully occupying Carlisle Avenue between College Avenue and Sheridan Avenue to move off said street.

Whereas, That part of the street now Carlisle Avenue between College Avenue and Sheridan Avenue, dedicated to the public for public use and highway by the Edw. Livingston heirs, in their plat of Edw. Livingston subdivision of a part of half Section No. 20, Township No. 5, Range No. 22, refuge lands in Marion Township, Franklin County, Ohio, and recorded on the plat thereof of record in Plat Book No. 2, page 275, Recorder's Office Franklin County, Ohio, is unlawfully obstructed and occupied by one L. B. Tussing and his assigns, one Anthony Boesch;

Therefore be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Berley, State of Ohio, that the clerk of the Village of Berley, State of Ohio send a notice to the said L. B. Tussing and the said Anthony Boesch to remove any obstruction placed on said street and to move off said street within ten days after receiving this notice; and be it further resolved by the Council of the Village of Berley, State of Ohio, that upon the said L. B. Tussing and the said Anthony Boesch failing within the specified time to remove any and all obstructions the Street Commissioner of said Village be herewith instructed and authorized to remove the same and clear the street.
