

Resolution No. 104

Whereas Kohbarger and Hoyles, the contractors for construction of the sewers in the Village of Besby, have failed to complete the work of constructing said sewers in accordance with the contract and specifications and,

Whereas said contractors have been notified to proceed with the completion of said work in accordance with said contract and specifications within three days from the date of said notice,

Therefore be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Besby, State of Ohio, that the Street Commissioners of said Village be and hereby is ordered to employ the necessary labor and procure the necessary material and machinery and to proceed ^{at once} under the direction of the Village engineer to restore the streets of said Village to the condition required by the contract between said Village and said contractors;

Resolved, further, that the cost and expense of completing said contract be charged to said contractors, and that said contractors be forthwith notified of the action of this Council.
