

Resolution 106 ✓

Whereas, the Council duly passed a resolution requiring a sidewalk to be constructed on the East side of Drexel Avenue from Broad Street North to the North line of Lot Four (4) on the amended plat of Block Five (5) Bullitt Park Addition, and

Whereas, Notices have been served as required by law on each of the property owners fronting upon said improvement requiring them to construct said sidewalk in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared therefor, within fifteen (15) days after the service of such notice, in default of which, the Village will construct the same at their expense, and

Whereas, Richard E. Jones, owner of Lot Number 5 in said Block Number Five, Kate E. Hoffer, owner of Lots Numbers Ten and Eleven in said Block Number Five, and Catharine E. F. Berry, owner of Lots One and Six in Block Number Six, of said Bullitt Park Addition, have failed for more than fifteen days to construct said sidewalks, in compliance with said notices

Now therefore Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Besley, State of Ohio, that the street commissioner of said Village be and hereby is authorized and directed to procure the necessary tools labor and material and to forthwith proceed to construct said sidewalks in front of the Lots aforesaid; that he keep an accurate account of the cost and expense of constructing said walks in front of each of the Lots aforesaid, and report the same to this Council
