

## Resolution No. 107 ✓

Declaring it necessary to issue and sell bonds of the Village of Besley, Ohio, for the purpose of paying the Village's part of the cost and expense of improving sundry streets and avenues of said Village, by grading, paving, and providing for the submission of the question of issuing such bonds to a vote of the electors of said Village.

Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Besley, State of Ohio (two thirds of all the members elected and appointed thereto concurring) that it is necessary to issue and sell bonds of said Village in the sum of thirty five thousand dollars (\$35,000.00) for the purpose of paying the Village's part of the cost and expense of improving the streets and avenues of said Village hereafter named, by grading, paving and constructing sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvements, to-wit:

College Avenue from the south corporation line to the south line of Main Street; Parkview Avenue from north line of Main Street to the north corporation line of said Village; Drexel Avenue from the north line of Main Street to the north line of Dale Avenue; Drexel Avenue from the north line of Broad Street to the south line of Denver Avenue; Columbia Avenue from the north line of Town Street to the north line of South Commonwealth Avenue; Town Street from the east line of Parkview Avenue to the west line of Drexel Avenue; Pleasant Ridge Avenue from the south line of Main Street to a point four hundred and eight and thirty-five hundredths (408.35) feet south of the south line of Leoklaue Avenue, and Main Street from the west corporation line to the east corporation line of said Village.

Be it resolved further that the question of issuing and selling said bonds of said Village for said purpose in the sum aforesaid, to-wit, the sum of \$35,000.00 be submitted to a vote of the qualified electors of said Village at a special election to be held in said Village at the regular voting place in said Village on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1915; that the Mayor be and he hereby is directed to give public notice of the time and

place of having said election in the manner provided by law, that the clerk and he hereby is directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the deputy state supervisors of Franklin County, Ohio.
