ORDINANCE NO. 54

GRANTING H. S. MERVIN THE RIGHT TO CONSTRUCT A
PRIVATE SEWER IN NORTH COMMONWEALTH AVE.

Be it ordained by the Village of the Council of Bexley, State of Ohio, as follows, to-wit:

SECTION 1. That H. S. Mervin be and hereby is granted the right to construct and keep in repair a six (6) inch vitrified pipe sewer in North Commonwealth Avenue in said Village from a point opposite the east line of lot two, block eleven, Bullitt Park Addition, to, and to connect with, an eight (8) inch vitrified pipe sewer constructed by said Village in North Parkview Avenue.

SECTION 2. That said sewer shall be constructed in accordance with the plat, plan and profile therefor prepared by A. Elliott Kimberly engineer of said village; and that said Mervin shall save and keep said Village harmless from all claims and suits for damages, by any person or persons, caused by or growing out of the work of constructing said sewer, and upon completion thereof he shall restore said street to its former condition of usefulness without unnecessary delay.

SECTION 3. That an accurate plan and profile of said sewer, and a plat, showing the lots abutting thereon, shall be filed with the board of trustees of public affairs of said Village, together with a statement of the cost of constructing said sewer, and, no person shall be granted a permit to tap said sewer unless he or she shall present to said board, a written receipt from said Mervin, his heirs or assigns for a proper proportion of the cost of constructing said sewer; provided, that said Village may at any time declare said sewer to be a public sewer, and thereupon said Village shall refund to said Mervin, his heirs or assigns, and such other person or persons as may have paid for the privilege of tapping said sewer as herein provided, the original cost of constructing the same.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and by the earliest date allowed by law after its passage.
