ORDINANCE NO. 56

GRANTING THE BEXLEY LAND COMPANY THE RIGHT TO

CONSTRUCT WATER PIPES IN THE VILLAGE OF

BEXLEY.

Whereas The Bexley Land Company is the owner of two adjacent tracts of land within the Village of Bexley, designated upon the recorded plats thereof as "Bullit Park Extension" and "Bullit Park Extension Number Two," which has been subdivided into lots and into streets and alleys dedicated to the public, and

Where as, said Land Company has caused plans for a system of water pipes and appurtenances to be prepared by A. Elliott Kimberly for said subdivisions, and

Whoreas, said system as planned conforms to the water system recently constructed by said Village, and

Whereas said Land Company desires permission to enter upon the streets, avenues and alleys in that part of said Village included within the subdivisions aforesaid for the purpose of constructing and laying said system of water pipes therein and when complete connect the same with the water pipes of said Village.

NOW THEREOFRE, Be It ordained by the council of the village of Bexley, State of Ohio, as follows, to-wit:

granted the right and privilege to enter upon the streets, avenues and alleys in that part of the Village of Bexley included within and abounding upon said Bullit Park Extension and Bullit Park Extension Number Two, and at its own cost and expense to construct therein a water pipes system; and while system is complete, to connect the same with said water system of said Village.

SECTION 2. That said water system shall be constructed in accordance with the plan, profile and specifications therefor, prepared by A. Elliott Kimberly; and that said Land Company shall save and keep said Village harmless from all claims and suits for damages by any person or persons, caused by or growing out of thework of laying said water pipes, and upon completion thereof

o shall restore said streets to their former condition of usefulness.

SECTION 3. That a copy of the plan, profiles and specifications of said water system shall be filed with the Board of Trustees of Public Affairs of said $\overset{\circ}{\text{Village}}$ and allopersons desiring permission to tap said pipes shall obtain a permit for that purpose from said Board of Trustees or other proper officers and shall be in all respects governed by the rules and regulations provided for the tapping and use of the water mains of said Village.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon the earliest date allowed by law after its passage.
