

## Resolution - 92 ✓

Resolution to Accept and Approve the Report of Mr. Forrest E. Ambrose, Engineer, as to Data of Street encroachments by lot owners and as to the survey made in setting Iron Pins at the Street Corners of Streets within the Village of Bexley, Ohio.

Whereas Mr. Forrest E. Ambrose, Engineer, was employed by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio, to make the necessary survey of the property lines of the Village of Bexley, so as to determine the proper and correct location of iron pins at all street intersections and to set iron pins at such street intersections where the same were missing; and at the same time to take data as to the encroachments of lot owners upon the streets of said Village; and

Whereas the said Forrest E. Ambrose, in accordance with said above instruction, has made the survey above mentioned, has set in accordance therewith all missing iron pins at street intersections, and has taken data of all obstructions and encroachments upon streets within the said Village of Bexley, and has made a complete report of the same and sent the same to the preceding Council of said Village of Bexley, dated March the 17<sup>th</sup>, 1913;

Therefore be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio, that the report of the said Forrest E. Ambrose, Engineer, relative to the above mentioned survey and setting of iron pins at street intersections and the taking of data as to the encroachments upon the streets by lot owners with fences, pillars and other obstructions be and is hereby accepted and approved, and that the same be filed in the Office of the Clerk of the Village of Bexley, Ohio
