

Resolution # 931

Resolution Instructing the Street Commissioner of the Village of Bexley, Ohio, to Remove or Cause to be Removed all Obstructions and Encroachments upon any and all Streets within the Village of Bexley, Ohio.

Whereas encroachments by lot owners upon the streets within the Village of Bexley, Ohio, through fences, pillars and other obstructions, is quite general, and

Whereas Mr. Forest E. Ambrose, Engineer, employed by the said Village of Bexley, Ohio and report all encroachments upon the said streets, has sent in his report and findings according to instructions, giving a detailed list of encroachments, and

Whereas a few other encroachments upon streets with the said Village of Bexley exist or may take place in the future,

Therefore be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio, That the Street Commissioner of said Village of Bexley be hereby and is instructed by the Council of said Village to serve each lot owner having encroached with fences, pillars or buildings upon any part of any street within the said Village of Bexley a written notice to remove the same within thirty days after the serving of said notice. That upon any lot owner or agent for a lot owner failing or refusing to remove all encroachments on the street in front of his lot after such notice has been served upon him by the Street Commissioner of said Village of Bexley, then it shall be the duty of the said Street Commissioner to forthwith remove or cause to be removed at the expense of the lot owner, any and all obstructions or encroachments upon the street of said Village be they of whatever nature or character, and that the costs of removing such obstructions be taxed up against the offending lot.

This resolution shall take effect and be in force the earliest period allowed by law.
