AN ORDINANCE NO. 101

To levy Special Assessments for the improvement of Pleasant Ridge Avenue from the South line of Mound Street to a point Four Hundred and Eight and Thirty-five Hundreths (408.35) Feet South of the South line of Carlisrue Avenue by grading, curbing, paving the roadway, constructing the sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement and constructing water and sewer connections from the water main and sewer in said Avenue.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:-

SECTION 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of improving Pleasant Ridge Avenue from the South line of Mount Street to a point Four Hundred and Eight and Thirty-five Hundreths (408.35) Feet south of the South line of Carlisrue Avenue in said Village by grading, curbing, paving the roadway with Concrete, constructing sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement and constructing water and sewer connections from the water main and sewer in said Avenue, to the inner line of the curbs on said Avenue as reported to Council on the 23rd day of September 1916 by the Board heretofore appointed to estimate said assessment, be and the same is hereby adopted, and that there be and hereby is levied and assessed upon the lots and lands hereinafter described the several amounts herein set forth, viz:-

It is hereby determined and declared that each of said lots and lands are specially benefited by said improvement in an amount equal to said assessment.

SECTION 2. That the total assessment shall be payable at the office of the Treasurer of the Village of Bexley, Ohio within a period of Thirty (30) days from the date of the first publication of this Ordinance, with interest at the rate of Five (5) Per Cent per annum from the 1st day of October 1915, or at the option of the owner in ten annual installments with interest at the rate of Five (5) Per Cent per annum upon deferred payments at the office of the Treasurer of Franklin County, Ohio after the same has been certified to the County Auditor for collection in the manner provided by law. The said assessment after being so certified may, however, be paid in full or in any number of annual installments at any tax collection time, with interest on the same to the semi-annual interest day next ensuing. If said installments of said assessment are not paid when the same become due, a penalty will be imposed and collected as provided by law.

SECTION 3. That said assessment and all portions thereof when collected shall be paid into the Sinking Fund and shall be applied to the payment of the bonds issued for

said improvement and the interest thereof as the same shall become due and to no other purpose whatsoever.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
