AN ORDINANCE NO. 103

TO FIX THE SALARIES, COMPENSATION AND BONDS OF VILLAGE OFFICIALS
AND EMPLOYEES.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley,
State of Ohio, as follows, to wit:

SECTION 1. That the salary of the Mayor of the Village shall be
75 Dollars per annum, in
addition to the fees and other compensation now or hereafter pro-
vided by law, and he shall give bond in the Sum of \$500.
Dollars.

SECTION 2. That the salary of the Clerk shall be _____
\$300. Dollars per annum, and he shall give bond
in the Sum of \$500. Dollars.

SECTION 3. That the salary of the Treasurer shall be _____
60 Dollars per annum, and he shall
give bond in the Sum of Twenty five hundred Dollars.

SECTION 4. That the salary of the Solicitor shall be _____
300 Dollars per annum for all services ren-
dered as attorney and Counsel for the Village and the officials
thereof in their official capacity, excepting for services render-
ed and advice to the Board of Trustees of Public Affairs, for which
service and advice such Solicitor shall receive from said Board the
additional Sum of One Hundred Dollars per annum; provided however,
said Solicitor shall not be required to render any service to the
Village or said Board in any litigated matters for the salary and

compensation aforesaid, but, in case his services should be required by said Village or said Board in any case or cases wherein the Village or said Board is involved or about to be involved in litigation, he shall receive for such services such sum or sums as may be agreed upon by such Solicitor and the Council. The Solicitor shall give bond in the Sum of 500 Dollars.

SECTION 5. The salary of Marshall shall be in the Sum of 850 Dollars per annum, in addition to such fees as are allowed by law, and he shall give bond in the Sum of 850 Dollars.

SECTION 6. The salary of the Street Commissioner of the Village shall be 8950 Dollars per annum; that the compensation of one assistant shall be Fifty Dollars per month, while continuously employed; the compensation of laborers shall be 25 Cents per hour; and the compensation for each team and driver employed by said Street Commissioner shall be 50¢ ^{cents} hour ^{hour} Dollars per day. Said Street Commissioner shall give bond in the Sum of 8500 Dollars.

SECTION 7. The salary of the Health Officer shall be _____ Dollars per annum, and in addition thereto the further compensation of _____ Cents per hour for necessary services rendered by him in behalf of the Village, shown in an itemized statement presented by him for the allowance

and action of the Council, and he shall give bond in the Sum of
_____ Dollars.

SECTION 8. The compensation of each Member of the Village Council shall be Two Dollars for each and every Meeting of the Council held, whether the same be a regular, adjourned or called meeting, provided said meetings shall not exceed twenty-four in any year, and provided further that no member of the Council shall receive any compensation whatever for any meetings of the Council which he does not attend, and answer to his name on roll call, as shown by the minutes of the Clerk.

SECTION 9. That the salaries and compensation of each of the above named officers and members of the Council of the Village shall be paid quarterly, except the salaries of the Clerk, Street Commissioner and Solicitor, which shall be paid monthly, out of the Village Treasury after the same has become due, upon resolution of the Council and the order of the Clerk upon the Treasurer; provided however, the Council by general ordinance or resolution may authorize and direct the Clerk and Treasurer to pay said salaries and compensation, when due as herein provided, without other action of the Council thereon.

SECTION 10. That ordinance No. 50 passed December 23rd, 1913 be and the same is hereby repealed.

SECTION 11. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force

from and after the earliest period allowed by law after its
passage.
