

Resolution No. 109.  
 Resolution Declaring it Necessary to  
 Make Sewer and Water Connections.

Resolved by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio, that as a sanitary regulation and in view of the contemplated improvement of certain streets of said village it is deemed necessary that all sewer and water connections be made by all owners of all lots and lands fronting and abutting upon the following streets to wit: - Main Street between the west corporation line and the east corporation line of said village; College Avenue between Main Street and Livingston Avenue; Drexel Avenue between Main Street and Dale Avenue; Drexel Avenue between Broad Street and Denver Avenue; Columbia Avenue between Town Street and South Commonwealth Avenue; Parkview Avenue between Main Street and the North corporation line of said village; Town Street between Parkview Avenue and Drexel Avenue; and Pleasant Ridge Avenue from Main Street to a point four hundred and eight and thirty-five hundredths (408.35) feet south of the south line of Carlisle Avenue.

Resolved further that written notice of the adoption of this resolution be given to the owner of each lot or parcel of land to which such connections are to be made and that such notice shall state the number and character of the connections required.

Resolved further that David Shadrach be and hereby is appointed to serve such notices in the manner provided for the service of summons in civil actions; provided that if any of said owners be non-residents of the corporation or cannot be found, such notice may be given by publication as required by law.
