RESOLUTION NO. 114

TO IMPROVE COLUMBIA AVENUE FROM TOWN STREET TO THE SOUTH
LINE OF SOUTH COMMONWEALTH AVENUE.

RESOLVED, By the council of the village of Bexley, state of
Ohio:

(a) That it is necessary to improve Columbia Avenue from Town Street to the South line of South Commonwealth Avenue of said village by grading, curbing, paving the roadway with brick, concrete, some form of asphalt or some form of treated macadam, constructing the sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement, and constructing water and sewer connections from the water main and sewer in said Avenue to the inner line of the curbs on said avenue; in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles of said proposed improvement prepared by the engineer of said village, which plans are hereby approved:

(b) That the grade of said Avenue as improved shall be as shown on the plans and profiles to wit:

West Curb: Beginning at the intersection of the West curb of Columbia Avenue with the North line of Town Street at an elevation of 99.72 ft. Village datum; thence a 0.45% ascending grade, 300 ft. to a point at elevation 101.8 ft; thence by a 0.36% descending grade, 300 ft. to a point at elevation 100 ft; thence by a 0.4% ascending grade, 800 ft. to a point at elevation 103.2 ft; thence by a 0.3% ascending grade, 700 ft. to a point at elevation 105.30 ft; thence by a 0.5% ascending grade 1100 ft. to a point at elevation 110.8 ft; thence by a vertical curve with elevation at 50 ft. of 110.89, at 100 ft. elevation 110.82 ft. at 150, elevation 110.59 and at 200, elevation 110.20 ft; thence by a 1.105% descending grade 190 ft. to the South line of Broad Street.

Then beginning with the intersection of the curb with North line of Broad Street at elevation 109.06 ft; thence by a 0.94% ascending grade 100 ft. to a point at elevation 110; thence by a 0.7% ascending grade for 974 ft. to a point at elevation 116.82 ft. at the South line of South Commonwealth Avenue.

East Curb: Beginning at a point in East curb line of Columbia and North line of Town Street at an elevation of 100.18 ft. Village datum; thence by 0.3% ascending grade 300 ft. to a point at elevation 101.08 ft. from which point curb

is at same elevation as west curb, to Broad Street.

Beginning at intersection of east curb with north line of Broad Street with an elevation of 109.46 ft; thence by a .54% ascending grade 100 ft. to a point at elevation 110 ft. from which point to the South line of South Commonwealth Avenue curb is same elevation as West curb.

(c) That the whole cost of said improvement, less one-fiftieth thereof and the cost of intersections, shall be assessed in proportion to the special benefits which may result from the improvement upon the following described lots and lands, to-wit: All lots and lands bounding and abutting upon the proposed improvement, which said lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefited by said improvement, and in an amount equal to the cost thereof.

(d) That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in ten annual installments, with interest on deferred payments at a rate not exceeding six per cent per annum; provided that the owner of any property assessed may, at his option, pay such assessment or any number of installments of the same at any time after such assessment has been levied, with interest to the semi-annual interest day of said bonds next following date of payment;

(e) That bonds of said village of Bexley Ohio, shall be issued in anticipation of collection of the assessments by installments, and in an amount equal thereto;

(f) That the remainder of the entire cost of said improvement shall be paid by the issuance of bonds of the village in the manner provided by law.
