

ORDINANCE NO. 73

DETERMINING TO PROCEED WITH THE IMPROVEMENT OF COLUMBIA AVENUE
FROM TOWN STREET TO THE SOUTH LINE OF SOUTH COMMONWEALTH AVENUE
IN THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, OHIO

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of
Ohio:

Section 1. That it is hereby determined to proceed with the improve-
ment of Columbia Avenue from Town Street to the South Line of South Commonwealth
Avenue in the Village of Bexley, Ohio, by grading, curbing, paving the roadway
with brick, concrete, some form of asphalt or some form of treated macadam, con-
structing the sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement
and constructing water and sewer connections from the water main and sewer in
said avenue to the inner line of the curbs on said avenue, in accordance with
the resolution declaring it necessary to improve said avenue, adopted by the
Council of said Village on the 18th day of March, 1915, and in accordance with
the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles of said proposed improvement
heretofore approved and now on file in the office of the Clerk of said Village.

Section 2. That all claims for damages resulting therefrom shall be
judicially inquired into after the completion of the proposed improvement and
the Village Solicitor be and he hereby is authorized and directed to institute
proceedings in a court of competent jurisdiction to inquire into such claims.

Section 3. That the whole cost of said improvement, together with
the interest on bonds issued in anticipation of the collection of assessments to
be levied for said improvement and all other necessary expenditures, less one
fiftieth (1/50) thereof and the cost of intersections, shall be assessed in pro-
portion to the special benefits which may result from the improvement upon the
following described lots and lands to-wit: All lots and lands fronting, bounding
or abutting upon said improvement on said avenue between Town Street to the South
line of South Commonwealth Avenue, which said lots and lands are hereby determined
to be specially benefited by said improvement, and in an amount equal to the cost
thereof.

Section 4. That the sum of fifty-two thousand one hundred Dollars
be and the same hereby is appropriated from the street improvement and inter-
section fund to pay the remainder and cost of said improvement.

Section 5. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in ten annual installments with interest on deferred payments at a rate not exceeding six per cent (6%) per annum; provided that the owner of any property assessed may, at his option, pay such assessments or any part of the installments thereof, at any time after said assessment has been levied, with interest to the semi-annual interest day of said bonds next following date of payment.

Section 6. That bonds of the Village of Bexley Ohio, shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of assessments by installments, and in an amount equal thereto.

Section 7. That the Clerk of said Village be and he hereby is authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement according to law.

Section 8. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
