ORDINANCE NO. 78

DETERMINATE TO PROCEED WITH THE IMPROVEMENT OF DREXEL AVENUE FROM MAIN STREET TO DALE AVENUE, IN THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, OHIO.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State

presement of Drexel Avenue from Main Street to Dale Avenue in said Village by frading, curbing, paving the readway with brick, concrete, some form of asphalt or some form of treated macadam, constructing the sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement and constructing water and sewer connections from the water main and sewer in said avenue to the inner line of the curbs on said avenue, in accordance with the resolution declaring it necessary to improve said avenue, adopted by the Council of said Village on the 22 day of April, 1915, and in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles of said proposed improvement heretofore approved and new on file in the office of the Clerk of said Village.

Section 2. That all claims for damages resulting therefrom shall be judicially inquired into after the completion of the proposed improvement and the Village Soliciter be and he is hereby authorized and directed to institute proceedings in a court of competent jurisdiction to inquire into such claims.

Section 3. That the whole cost of said imprevement, together with the interest on bonds issued in anticipation of the collection of assessments to be levied for said imprevement and all other negessary expenditures, less one fiftieth (1/50) thereof and the cost of intersections, shall be assessed in propertien to the special benefits which may result from the imprevement upon the following described lets and lands to wit: All lets and lands fronting, bounding or abutting upon said imprevement on said avenue between Main Street and Dale Avenue, which said lets and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefited by said imprevement, and in an amount equal to the cost thereof.

Section 4. That the sum of <u>Horty-Six hundred</u> Dellars be and the same hereby is apprepriated from the street imprevement and intersection fund to pay the remainder and cost of said imprevement.

Section 5. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in ten annual installments with interest on deferred payments at a rate not exceeding six per cent (6%) per annum; provided that the owner of any preperty assessed may, at his option, pay such assessments or any part of the installments thereof, at any time after said assessment has been levied, with interest to the semi-annual interest day of said bonds next following date of payment.

Section 6. That bonds of the Village of Bexley, Ohio, shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of assessments by installments, and in an amount equal thereto.

Section 7. That the Clerk of said Village be and he hereby is authorized and prected to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement according to law.

Section 8. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
