

AN ORDINANCE NO 38

To fix the compensation of the Village Solicitor for extraordinary services.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio as follows to wit:

SECTION 1. That for extraordinary services rendered by the Solicitor of said Village in connection with the improvement of certain streets of said Village, which services are not included in those required to be rendered under Ordinance No. 50 heretofore passed by this Council defining the duties of the Solicitor for which compensation is thereby provided, said Solicitor shall be paid the sum of one hundred and fifty Dollars for each block

SECTION 2. That said sum shall be divided equally among the streets improved and assessed as part of the cost of improvement, except that portion thereof which the Village is by law required to pay.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest time required by law.
