AN ORDINANCE NO. 116

DETERMINING TO PROCEED WITH THE IMPROVEMENT OF
DREXEL AVENUE FROM THE NORTH LINE OF DENVER AVENUE TO THE SOUTH
LINE OF MARYLAND AVENUE IN THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY,
OHIO.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State
of Ohio:

Section 1. That it is hereby determined to proceed
with the improvement of Drexel Avenue from the north line of
Denver Avenue to the south line of Maryland Avenue in said
Village by grading, curbing, paving the roadway with brick,
concrete, some form of asphalt, or some form of treated
macadam. Constructing sewers necessary to furnish proper
drainage for such improvement, constructing water and sewer
connections from the water main and sewer in said avenue to
the inner line of the curbs on said avenue, in accordance
with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles of said
proposed improvement heretofore approved and now on file in
the office of the Clerk of said Village.

Section 2. That all claims for damages resulting
therefrom shall be judicially inquired into after the completion
of the proposed improvement and the Village Solicitor be and
he hereby is authorized and directed to institute proceedings
in a court of competent jurisdiction to inquire into such claims.

Section 3. That the whole cost of said improvement,
together with the interest on the bonds issued in anticipation
of the collection of assessments to be levied for said improve-
ment and other necessary expenditures shall be assessed by the
foot frontage upon the following described lots and lands to-wit:

All lots and lands fronting, bounding and abutting upon
the proposed improvement, which lots and lands are hereby deter-
mined to be specially benefited by said improvement, and in an
amount equal to the cost thereof.

Section 4. That the assessments so to be levied shall
be paid in ten annual installments with interest on deferred
payments at a rate not to exceed six per cent (6%) per annum;

provided, that the owner of any property assessed may, at his option, pay such assessments or any part of the installments thereof, at any time after said installment has been levied, with interest to the semi-annual interest day of said bonds next following date of payment.

Section 5. That bonds of the Village of Bexley Ohio shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of assessments by installments and in an amount equal thereto.

Section 6. That the Clerk of said Village be and he hereby is authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement according to law.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
