AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF INTERURBAN RAILWAY CARS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, OHIO.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That no interurban railway car or cars shall be propelled or driven in, upon or over any of the streets or avenues within the corporate limits of Bexley, Ohio at a rate of speed in excess of eight (8) miles per hour.

SECTION 2. That any person or persons, company or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof be fined not less than Five (5) Dollars nor more than One Hundred (100) Dollars.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
