AN ORDINANCE TO PROTECT THE SIDEWALKS, GUTTERS AND CURBING  
UPON THE STREETS AND AVENUES IN THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, OHIO.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley,  
State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. No person or persons shall drive,  
move or haul any loaded wagon or truck, or cause the same  
to be done upon or over the sidewalks, curbs or gutters  
upon any improved street or avenue in said Village, except  
at places where regular driveways have been constructed or  
are designed to be constructed from an improved roadway  
into the adjacent property.

SECTION 2. Any person violating the provisions of  
this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be fined not  
less than Five or more than Twenty-five Dollars for each  
offense.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and  
be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by  
law.
