AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE WIDTH OF TIRES AND  
THE WEIGHT OF LOADS TO BE MOVED OVER THE STREETS AND AVENUES  
OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, OHIO.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State  
of Ohio;

SECTION 1. No vehicle carrying a load of three  
tons or more shall be hauled or moved over or upon any of the  
streets or avenues of the Village unless the tires on the  
wheels of such vehicle <sup>are smooth and</sup> ~~shall be~~ at least four inches in width.

<sup>Ten</sup>  
~~Five~~ tons, including the weight of its load, shall be  
hauled, driven or moved on or over any street or avenue in  
said Village.

SECTION 3. Any person or persons violating or  
causing a violation of the provisions of this ordinance  
shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction  
thereof shall be fined in a sum not exceeding Twenty-five  
Dollars for the first offence, and for a second and any  
additional offence in a sum not less than ten or more than  
Fifty Dollars, or be imprisoned not more than thirty days.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and  
be in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
