AN ORDINANCE.

No. 131

To levy Special Assessments for the improvement of College Avenue from Main Street to Livingston Avenue by grading, curbing, paving the roadway, constructing the sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement and constructing water and sewer connections from the water main and sewer in said Avenue; and to repeal Ordinance No. 98 adopted the 23rd day of October 1915.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:-

SECTION 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of improving College Avenue from Main Street to Livingston Avenue in said Village by grading, curbing, paving the roadway, constructing sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement and constructing water and sewer connections from the water main and sewer in said Avenue to the inner line of the curbs on said Avenue as reported to Council on the 22nd day of August 1916 by the Board heretofore appointed to estimate said assessment, be and the same is hereby adopted and that there be and hereby is levied and assessed upon the lots and lands hereinafter described the several amounts herein set forth, viz:-

It is hereby determined and declared that each of said lots and lands are specially benefited by said improvement in an amount equal to said assessment.

SECTION 2. That the total assessment shall be payable at the office of the Treasurer of the Village of Bexley, Ohio, within a period of Fifteen (15) days from the date of the final passage of this Ordinance, or at the option of the owner, in ten annual installments with interest at the rate of Five (5) Per Cent per annum upon deferred payments, at the office of the Treasurer of Franklin County, Ohio, after the same has been certified to the County Auditor for collection in the manner provided by law. Said assessment, after being so certified,

may be paid in full or any number of annual installments may be paid at any tax collection time, with interest on the same to the semi-annual interest day next ensuing: to wit, October first or April first. If said installments of said assessment are not paid when the same become due, a penalty will be imposed and collected as provided by law.

SECTION 3. That said assessment and all portions thereof when collected shall be paid into the Sinking Fund and shall be applied to the payment of the bonds issued for said improvement and the interest thereof as the same shall become due and to no other purpose whatsoever.

SECTION 4. That Ordinance No. ____, adopted on the _____ day of _____ 1915, "To levy special assessments for the improvement of College Avenue from Main Street to Livingston Avenue, etc.", be and the same hereby is repealed.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
