AN ORDINANCE.

No. 132

To levy Special Assessments for the improvement of Pleasant Ridge Avenue from the south line of Mound Street to a point 408.35 feet south of the south line of Carlsrue Avenue by grading, curbing, paving the roadway, constructing the sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement and constructing water and sewer connections from the water main and sewer in said Avenue; and to repeal Ordinance No. 101 adopted the 23 day of October 1915.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:-

SECTION 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of improving Pleasant Ridge Avenue from the south line of Mound Street to a point 408.35 feet south of the south line of Carlsrue Avenue in said Village by grading, curbing, paving the roadway, constructing sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement and constructing water and sewer connections from the water main and sewer in said Avenue to the inner line of the curbs on said Avenue as reported to Council on the 6th day of September 1916 by the Board heretofore appointed to estimate said assessment, be and the same is hereby adopted and that there be and hereby is levied and assessed upon the lots and lands hereinafter described the several amounts herein set forth, viz:-

Sec. 7. — And the Village Clerk is hereby authorized to draw his warrants on the Village Treasurer for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefor, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same; or an ordinance or resolution of council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. Provided further that the appropriation for "Contingent Fund" can only be expended for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village, and for purposes other than those covered by the other specific appropriations herein made.

Sec. 8. — This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.

It is hereby determined and declared that each of said lots and lands are specially benefited by said improvement in an amount equal to said assessment.

SECTION 2. That the total assessment shall be payable at the office of the Treasurer of the Village of Bexley, Ohio, within a period of Fifteen (15) days from the date of the final passage of this Ordinance, or at the option of the owner, in ten annual installments with interest at the rate of Five (5) Per Cent per annum upon deferred payments, at the office of the Treasurer of Franklin County, Ohio, after the same has been certified to the County Auditor for collection in the manner provided by law. Said assessment, after being so certified, may be paid in full or any number of annual installments may be paid at any tax collection time, with interest on the same to the semi-annual interest day next ensuing: to wit, October first or April first. If said installments of said assessment are not paid when the same become due, a penalty will be imposed and collected as provided by law.

SECTION 3. That said assessment and all portions thereof when collected shall be paid into the Sinking Fund and shall be applied to the payment of the bonds issued for said improvement and the interest thereon as the same shall become due and to no other purpose whatsoever.

SECTION 4. That Ordinance No. _____, adopted on the _____ day of _____ 1915, "To levy special assessments for the improvement of Pleasant Ridge Avenue from the south line of Mound Street to a point 408.35 feet south of the south line of Carlsrue Avenue, etc.", be and the same hereby is repealed.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
