It is hereby determined and declared that each of said lots and lands are specially benefited by said improvement in an amount equal to said assessment.

SECTION 2. That the total assessment shall be payable at the office of the Treasurer of the Village of Bexley, Chic, within a period of Fifteen (15) days from the date of the final passage of this Ordinance, or at the option of the owner, in ten annual installments with interest at the rates of Five (5) Per Cent per annum upon deferred rayments, at the ordine of the treasurer of Franklin County, Chic, after the same has been certified to the County Auditor for collection in the manner provided by law. Said assessment, after being so certified, may be paid in full or any number of annual installments may be paid at any tex sollection time, with interest on the same to the semi-annual interest day next ensuing; to wit, wotober first or April first. If said installments of said assessment are not paid when the same become due, a penalty will be imposed and collected as provided by law.

SECTION 3. That said assessment and all portions thereof when collected shall be paid into the Sinking Fund and shall be applied to the payment of the bonds issued for said improvement and the interest thereon as the same shall hecome due and to no other purpose whatsoever.

section 4. That Ordinance No. 132, adopted on the 265 day of Assessments for the improvement of Pleasant Ridge Avenue from the south line of Mound Street to a point 400.55 feet south of the south line of Carlsrue Avenue, etc.", be and the same hereby is repealed.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
