

Resolution No. 153.

To improve North Commonwealth Avenue from the East line of Parkview Avenue to the West line of Drexel Avenue.

Resolved by the Council of the Village of Besley, State of Ohio:-

(a) That it is necessary to improve North Commonwealth Avenue from the East line of Parkview Avenue to the West line of Drexel Avenue in said Village, by grading, curbing, paving the roadway with brick, concrete, some form of asphalt or some form of treated macadam, constructing the sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement, and constructing water and sewer connections from the water main and sewer in said Avenue to the inner curb line of said Avenue, in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles of said improvement prepared by the engineers of said Village, which plans are hereby approved and filed in the office of the Village Clerk.

(b) That the grade of said Avenue as improved shall be as shown on the plans and profiles to-wit:-

North curb:- Beginning at the intersection of the north curb of North Commonwealth Avenue with the East line of Parkview Avenue at an elevation of 112.40 Village datum; thence on a 1.355 per cent. ascending grade 225 feet to a point of elevation 115.45; thence by a vertical curve 150 feet to a point of elevation 117.06; thence on a 0.743 per cent. ascending grade for 151 feet to a point of elevation 118.18; thence across the intersection of Columbia Avenue 28 feet to a point of elevation 118.18; thence on a 0.30 per cent. descending grade 528 feet to a point of elevation 116.60

South curb:- Beginning at the intersection of the

South curb of North Commonwealth Avenue with the east line of Oakview Avenue at a point of elevation 112.20; thence on a 1.444% ascending grade for 225 feet to a point of elevation 115.45; thence by grades same as north curb to the end of the improvement.

(c) That the whole cost of said improvement less one-fiftieth ($\frac{1}{50}$) thereof, and the cost of inter-sections shall be assessed by the foot front upon the following described lots and lands to-wit: All lots and lands bounding and abutting upon the proposed improvement, which lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefited by said improvement and in amount equal to the thereof.

(d) That the assessment so to be levied shall be paid in ten (10) annual installments with interest on deferred payments at a rate not exceeding six per cent (6%) per annum; provided that the owner of any property assessed may, at his option, pay each assessment or any number of installments of the same at any time after such assessment has been levied, with interest to the semi-annual interest day of bonds issued in anticipation of the collection of such assessments next following date of payment.

(e) That bonds of said Village of Bexley, Ohio, shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of assessments by installments and in amount equal thereto.

(f) That the remainder of the entire cost of said improvement, not specially assessed, shall be paid by the issuance of bonds of said Village in the manner provided by law.
