AN ORDINANCE

To levy special assessments for the improvement of Drexel Avenue from the north line of Denver Avenue to the south line of Maryland Avenue, by grading, curbing, paving the roadway, constructing sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement, and constructing water connections from the water main in said avenue to the inner line of the curbs.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That to pay the portion of the cost and expenses heretofore determined to be specially assessed for the improvement of Drexel Avenue from the north line of Denver Avenue to the south line of Maryland Avenue by grading, curbing and paving the roadway with bitulithic, constructing sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement, and constructing water connections from the water main in said avenue to the inner line of the curbs, there be levied and assessed upon the lots and lands hereinafter described the several amounts herein set forth, viz:

SECTION 2. That the total assessment shall be payable at the office of the Treasurer of the Village of Bexley, Ohio, within a period of thirty (30) days from the date of the final passage of this Ordinance, or at the option of the owner, in ten annual installments with interest at the rate of Five (5) Per Cent per annum upon deferred payments, at the office of the Treasurer of Franklin County, Ohio, after the same has been certified to the County Auditor for collection in the manner provided by law. Said assessment, after being so certified may be paid in full or any number of annual installments may be paid at any tax collection time, with interest on the same to the semi-annual interest day next ensuing; towit, <sup>Septem</sup> October first or <sup>Mar</sup> April first. If said installments of said assessment are not paid when the same become due, a penalty will be imposed and collected as provided by law.

SECTION 3. That said assessment and all portions thereof when collected shall be paid into the Sinking Fund and shall be applied to the payment of the bonds issued for said improvement and the interest thereon as the same shall become due and to no other purpose whatsoever.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
