

AN ORDINANCE.

No. 144

TO CHANGE THE NAME OF TOWN STREET BETWEEN WESTLAND AVENUE AND DREXEL AVENUE TO THE NAME "BRYDEN ROAD".

WHEREAS, on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1917, a petition by persons owning lots on Town Street in the Village of Bexley, between Westland and Drexel Avenues, was duly presented to Council praying that the name of said Town Street between said point, be changed to "Bryden Road", and

WHEREAS, council upon hearing is satisfied that there is good cause for said change of name as prayed for, and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made,

Now Therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio.

SECTION 1. That the name of Town Street in said Village between Westland Avenue and Drexel Avenue be and the same is hereby changed to "Bryden Road".

SECTION 2. That this ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
